'Forget-me-not' is the name of the liaison committee of bereaved parents at the Maternity, Gynaecological and Paediatric wards of the Ulster Hospital. It was set up in 2007 to improve and enhance the experience of parents who have been bereaved through miscarriage, stillbirth, neonatal death or the death of a child.

What do we do?

We meet approximately 6 times a year and have influenced the care provided during the very sensitive time following loss.

We have raised funds to provide memory boxes, digital cameras and special baby blankets and many other items for the use of bereaved parents.
